The naval architect is the designer of the vessel; he/she designs the shape, the hull and internal layout. During design phase, naval architects deal with statutory reference tables, defining the fitting and hydrostatic-hydrodynamic properties of the vessel.

The naval architect ensures quality and the respect of costs and deadlines. He/she must also be careful of the client's needs. He/she is concerned with safety and the environment.
